Our rebuilding shop provides high grade, custom built Sitka Spruce soundboard panels to the trade. I personally select all wood on-site in Canada. We specialize in beautiful uniform grain Sitka Spruce. The age of these trees ranges from 600 to 1000 years old. Grade A quality Spruce comes in various colors 14 to 28 grains per inch. Average pieces are 4 to 10 inches wide. All logs are nicely quarter sawn and sorted so, when possible, wood from the same cant can be placed into the same soundboard, offering excellent color matched panels.

All panels are passed through a large industrial panel sander which produces a consistent panel thickness, beautifully flattening the panel. No final sanding is required, and no dips or valleys assuring a perfect rib glue joint. For the belly man, this is a value-added feature! All the wood is thoroughly air and kilned dried.

Rib stocks available. Standard lengths and widths, or custom ordered. Sitka Spruce and California Sugar Pine available. White Spruce and Northern White Pine as per availability. Alaskan Yellow Cedar, Red Cedar, and other tone woods on request.




